QISD Awards presented at the ASI Awards Night

The 2004 Australian Steel Institute - Awards Night was held at the Brisbane Convention Centre on Friday 16th of July. As you are no doubt aware, the primary aim of the QISD is to do what we can to address the issue of design documentation quality. This year, the strategies we have developed to tackle this issue culminated at the annual ASI Steel Awards with the presentation of two QISD awards for Excellence in Design Documentation Quality.

The QISD felt that those designers producing drawings of a high standard, containing accurate and full information should be recognised and rewarded for their efforts.

This event not only highlighted the issue of Design Documentation Quality in a positive and constructive manner but also launched the QISD Documentation Check Lists which focus on the particular aspects of design documentation that most affect steel detailers.

The QISD recognised two design consultants who, QISD members have judged, to have made the effort to provide an ethical & professional service to the industry.

The winners were judged against 15 criteria which are part of the Design Documentation Checklists used by members of the QISD. The QISD website at www.qisd.org.au <<http://www.qisd.org.au>> contains more information.
